II	ABOUT PROCEDURE TO GET ADMISSION AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:
7	What is the procedure to get for admission to various degree programs?
	<p>a) For admission to B.Tech. (Computer Science, Civil, Electrical, Electronics and Communication, Mechanical and Textile Engineering), first two centralized counselling will be done by IKGPTU. The candidate is advised to visit www.ptu.ac.in and fill the choices. The first counselling would start tentatively in End May, 2026. Third counselling onwards would be done by MRSPTU Bathinda at www.mrspt.ac.in. No separate test is conducted for admission.</p> <p>b) The admission to rest of the programs would be done at MRSPTU Bathinda.</p> <p>Visit https://mrsptu.ac.in/admissions2026-2027.php for Pre-registration before declaration of qualifying exam result and furthermore update the registration form for latest qualification information after the declaration of qualifying exam result.</p> <p>The merit list shall be prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination, as per the eligibility criteria of the respective degree program. No separate test is conducted for admission.</p>
8	How can I apply for admission?
	<p>The Pre-registration for Admission is open for all degree programs for session 2026-27. The candidate can register by paying a non-refundable amount of Rs 3000/-. This amount would be adjusted in the first semester fee at the time of admission. Click at following link for registration: https://mrsptu.ac.in/admissions2026-2027.php. The entire admission process shall be conducted in online mode only. However, the candidate, once seat is allotted, must visit MRSPTU or the respective allotted college at the time of admission confirmation and document verification.</p> <p>For any queries, support, or assistance, candidate may: Contact the Admission Cell telephonically, or Visit the University physically at Room No. 8, Administration Building, MRSPTU, Bathinda, or Visit the respective college where they intend to take admission. 9	Do I need to visit the University Campus / Admission Office to receive or submit the application form?
	<p>No, the candidate is not required to visit the University Campus or Admission Office for receiving or submitting the application form. The entire admission process is conducted in online mode only. However, candidates must visit MRSPTU or the respective allotted college at the time of admission confirmation and document verification. 11 Can I apply for admission to a program in MRSPTU before the declaration of the result of the qualifying examination?

	<p>Pre-registration for admission to all degree programs for the academic session 2026–27 is currently open at MRSPTU by paying a non-refundable fee of ₹3000/-, which will be adjusted in the first semester fee at the time of admission.</p> <p>To register, please visit: https://www.mrsptuadmissions.com/preregistration/registration.aspx</p> <p>The final admission process will commence after the declaration of the results of the qualifying examination.</p>
12	<p>When is the last date to submit the application?</p>
	<p>The admission process for all programs offered at MRSPTU, Bathinda and its affiliated colleges will remain open until 15th August 2026.</p> <p>However, the last date may be extended by the Government as per official notifications. Candidate is advised to regularly visit the official admission portal for updates: https://mrsptu.ac.in/admissions2026-2027.php</p>
13	<p>If I want to apply for more than one course/program, do I need to fill out multiple application forms?</p>
	<p>Yes, candidate is required to fill out separate application (pre-registration) forms for each program of their choice at MRSPTU, subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria for each selected program. The registration fee paid for multiple applications will be adjusted in the first semester fee at the time of confirmation of admission, as per university norms.</p>
14	<p>Can I depute someone as a nominee for counselling if I am unable to attend in person?</p>
	<p>Yes, a candidate may authorize a representative to attend counselling on their behalf at MRSPTU. The authorized representative must carry a duly signed authority letter from the candidate at the time of counselling. The University may also require the representative to present valid identification documents for verification purposes.</p> <p>However, the candidate has to be present at the time of confirmation of admission.</p>
15	<p>I have a gap in studies? Can I get admission in university?</p>

17	<p>Can I take back the original documents?</p> <p>a) The original certificates (10th certificate, Scheduled Caste certificate, and income certificate) of Punjab resident candidate belonging to the SC/ST category and applying for scholarship under PMSS shall be retained at the time of admission.</p> <p>b) All other candidates are required to bring original documents for verification and submit the photocopies of their original documents at the time of admission.</p> <p>c) Further, all candidates shall be required to deposit their original documents in their respective departments after the commencement of classes for verification purposes.</p>



22	Is there any facility for payment of fees in instalments?																														
	No, there is no standard provision for payment of fees in instalments. However, in exceptional cases, the candidate may be allowed to pay the admission fee (security amount + first semester fee only) in two instalments, subject to approval by the competent authority on a case-to-case basis.																														
23	In whose favour should the fee Demand Draft (DD) be made, and where should it be drawn?																														
	Applicants are advised to make payments through the online mode. However, if paying via cheque or Demand Draft (DD), it should be drawn in favour of “Registrar, MRSPTU Bathinda”, payable at Bathinda.																														
24	Is education loan facility available?																														
	MRSPTU will assist candidate in obtaining an education loan by providing all the required documents to the bank for loan processing and disbursement.
